DAY 1 TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Today we depart from the USA to **Tel Aviv, Israel**. Meals served in flight.

DAY 2 ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to our hotel for check in, dinner and a good night's sleep. (D)

DAY 3 CAESAREA / MT. CARMEL / MEGIDDO / NAZARETH VILLAGE / NAZARETH / CANA

After our delicious buffet breakfast, travel to **Caesarea** by the Sea on the Mediterranean coastline. It was here that Cornelius the Centurion and his household were saved and baptized (Acts 10), and it was also where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome (Acts 25 & 26). See the top of **Mt. Carmel**, where Elijah prayed down the fire from heaven and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (I Kings 18). Visit **Megiddo** and the **Valley of Armageddon** (Rev. 16). Step back in time 2,000 years as we walk through the "**Nazareth Village**", a Biblically recreated farm and Galilean Village depicting life as our Lord would have known it during His childhood. Pass through **Cana** where the Lord performed His first miracle (Jn. 2) before arriving in **Tiberias** for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

DAY 4 BOAT RIDE / CAPERNAUM / MT. OF BEATITUDES / BETHSAIDA / CHORAZIN / KORSI / GALILEE EXPERIENCE (TIBERIAS)

This morning, we enjoy a beautiful boatride across the **Sea of Galilee**. Then we visit the remains of **Capernaum** (Lk. 4) and stand in what is left of the synagogue in which our Lord ministered. Visit the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7), then visit **Bethsaida** (home of at least three of the disciples) and **Chorazin**. These three cities were cursed by the Lord (Lk. 10) and are no longer in existence today. We will also drive through the country of the **Gadarenes (Korsi)** where the man with the legion of

demons was delivered (Matt. 8). Also included in today's itinerary is the *Galilee Experience*, a multi-media attraction about the history of Israel and the Galilee area. (B/D)

DAY 5 JORDAN RIVER / BEIT SHEAN / GIDEON SPRINGS / JORDAN VALLEY / JERUSALEM

We enjoy our buffet breakfast and then check out of our hotel in the Galilee. First stop is the **Jordan River**, site where many pilgrim groups have a baptismal service. Then it is on to the tel of **Beit Shean** where the bodies of King Saul and his sons hung from the city gates (I Sam. 31). Also visit **Ein Harod (Gideon's Spring)** where Gideon chose his army of 300 by observing how they drank from the spring (Jg. 7). We will pass by **Jericho**, the ancient city destroyed by the power of God and travel through the **Judean Wilderness** on our way to **Jerusalem**. We take a few minutes to view the city before checking into our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

DAY 6 MT. OF OLIVES / PALM SUNDAY ROAD / GETHSEMANE / VIA DOLOROSA / POOL OF BETHESDA / GARDEN TOMB

We begin our sightseeing on the top of the **Mt. of Olives** (II Sam. 15 & Lk. 9). Walk down the **Palm Sunday Road**, see olive trees on the Mt. of Olives that date back to the time of our Lord and take time to pray in the **Garden of Gethsemane** (Jn. 18). Walk the **Via Dolorosa** through the streets of old Jerusalem, and remember the miracle of the lame man at the **Pool of Bethesda** (Jn. 5). Finally, we end our day by sensing the agony of our Lord's crucifixion at **Gordon's Calvary** (Lk. 23) and experience the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the **Garden Tomb**. (B/D)

DAY 7 TEMPLE MOUNT / SOUTHERN WALL EXCAVATIONS / MODEL OF 2ND TEMPLE JERUSALEM / VIEW OF KNESSET / ISRAEL MUSEUM - SHRINE OF THE BOOK / VIEW OF BETHLEHEM

The temple mount awaits us as our



first stop this morning. Walk up onto the **Temple Mount** where Herod's Temple stood and remember the events that took place at this sacred site. View the recently uncovered **Southern Wall Excavations** and the famous **Western Wall** which is a part of the ancient temple mount site. The **Model of 2nd Temple Jerusalem** gives us an outstanding presentation of how the city appeared 2,000 years ago. We will view the **Knesset Building** (Israel's Parliament) and include the **Israel Museum** and **Shrine of the Book Museum**, home to ancient Israel artifacts and some of the Dead Sea Scrolls parchments. Before returning to our hotel, we will find a lookout point which will give us a view of modern day **Bethlehem**, city of birth for the Savior of the World. (B/D)

DAY 8 DEAD SEA / MASADA / EIN GEDI / QUMRAN

After another great breakfast, we will return to the Judean Wilderness, driving along the shores of the **Dead Sea** to the spectacular mountaintop fortress of **Masada** built by Herod. Masada is famous for being the last stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. From the top of Masada the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp can still be seen. Visit the **Ein Gedi** reserve, home to native wildlife and area where David hid from King Saul (I Sam. 23). Final stop is **Qumran**, located on the northern portion of the Dead Sea, and famous for being the site where the Dead Sea scrolls were discovered. We return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B/D)

DAY 9 SAMUEL'S TOMB / AYALON VALLEY / EMMAUS / BET SHEMESH / ELAH VALLEY / CAVES OF BET GUVRIN / TEL MARESHA

This morning we make our way to **Samuel's Tomb**. From this vantage point we have an outstanding view of the surrounding land of Jerusalem and ancient borders of a few of the original twelve tribes. As we continue west we view the **Ayalon Valley** where God caused the sun to stand still so the Amorites were completely defeated by Joshua and the armies of Israel (Joshua 10). Walk into the remains of a Byzantine Church built on the site of **Emmaus**, where the Lord revealed His resurrection to the two disciples (Lk. 24). **Beth Shemesh** boasts a remarkable, man made underground water system and the site where the ark of the covenant was returned on a cow-pulled cart from the land of the Philistines (I Sam. 6). We will stand in the **Valley of Elah**, famous as the site of the battle between David and Goliath. See remarkable caves, known as **Bell Caves** hewn out of the soft chalk in the area of Bet Guvrin and visit the **tel of Maresha**, a city built by King Rehoboam. This evening we prepare for our flight back to the USA. (B/D)

DAY 10 ARRIVE IN THE USA

We arrive in the USA with a lifetime of memories to cherish. Meals served in flight.

Roommates may be assigned as late as 35 days prior to departure and, if one is not available or you request a single room, the following charges apply: \$400 during the tour.

ITINERARY CHANGES: If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$90 per night; single rooms \$130 per night. Meals for extra nights are not included.

CANCELLATION FEES: 100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Insurance Program provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take insurance should be aware of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 90 days prior to departure, you will be charged the \$55 non-refundable administrative fee.
